



March 24, 2026 – Superintendent’s Report

ADMINISTRATIVE UPDATE:

The Utilities along with American Structurepoint held the public bid opening for the Lawrence 46th & Post I/I (inflow & Infiltration) Removal Project on March 13, 2026, at Community Park located at 5301 N. Franklin Road. This project is one of the necessary projects to comply with the Sanitary Sewer Overflow Corrective Action Plan as part of the Administrative Order on Consent we are under with the Environmental Protection Agency due to chronic sanitary sewer overflows during heavy rain events.

Five sealed bids were received and are currently under review by American Structurepoint for accuracy and to make sure that all required documentation was included in the contractor bid packets. The following contractors submitted bids for this project:

- Performance Pipelining Inc - \$2,227,499.50
- InLiner Solutions, LLC - \$2,656,130.00
- BLD Services, LLC - \$1,894,725.00
- Insituform Technologies USA, LLC - \$1,837,762.76
- SLB Pipe Solutions, LLC - \$1,822,135.00

Barring any unforeseen circumstances, we plan to place the Notice of Award on the April 14th agenda for the Board’s consideration and approval.

As mentioned in my report for the last meeting, both the Fort Harrison Capacity Improvements PH III and the 71st Street Lift Station Basin I/I Removal project are nearing completion. If all goes as scheduled and the weather cooperates, these two projects should be completed by the end of April 2026.

We have four account adjustments on the agenda for this meeting and Lawrence Utilities does recommend approval for all four.

Account Adjustments:

1. 4829 Mindy Drive - customer requesting a sanitary sewer adjustment for \$253.15 due to a leak caused by a busted pipe. We recommend approval.
2. 7719 Baywood Drive - customer requesting a sanitary sewer adjustment for \$286.68 due to a leak caused by a busted pipe. We recommend approval.
3. 10502 Hermosa Drive - customer requesting a sanitary sewer adjustment for \$301.39 due to a leak caused by a busted pipe. We recommend approval.
4. 7729 Camfield Way - customer requesting a sanitary sewer adjustment for \$2,334.18 due to a leak caused by a busted pipe in the wall. This adjustment is for a little over three months. We recommend approval.
