



October 14, 2025 – Superintendent’s Report

ADMIN UPDATE:

The Utilities are seeking approval of Task Order No. 7 with American Structurepoint for a lump sum fee of \$237,600.00 for the Study and Report Phase for Wet Weather Storage Basins that were included in the Sanitary Sewer Overflow Corrective Action Plan that was submitted to the EPA as part of the requirements of the Administrative Order on Consent (AOC) issued to the City of Lawrence in 2021. As previously stated, we are “on the clock” and are required to complete elimination of all chronic sanitary sewer overflows identified in the AOC by April 18, 2030.

The Fort Harrison Capacity Improvements Project Phase III (Shafter Road sanitary sewer improvements project) continues on schedule. Our next progress meeting for the project will be held on 10/15/2025 with the project engineer, contractor, and DNR.

The necessary security upgrades to the Utility Business Office Lobby and building are well underway. It is our hope to have the lobby opened by early November if not sooner, but an exact date is not available currently as some of the exterior work is weather dependent and there are two separate contractors coordinating performing work on site. I will be sure to communicate an exact date as soon as that becomes clearer. If that date is between scheduled USB meetings, I will make sure to send an email to all members of the Utility Service Board to inform them on the matter.
