#### **OLD BUSINESS:**

#### 19-LSV-08 ~ 6023 TWYCKENHAM DR

Petitioner, Kevin Brown, and his representative, Bennell Small, presented the case for a Variance of Development Standards of Section 744-201 to allow a deck that is 30" above grade and located 12" from the property line (20' required) reducing the open space to 61% (65% required).
