He also expressed gratitude to the Water Utility for their quick response and repair of the water leak in the Maple Bluff subdivision.

<u>APPROVAL OF VOUCHERS 2-17-21</u>: Councilor Freeman moved to approve Payroll Claims for \$908,885.29 [January 31, 2021 payroll], Payroll Claims for \$948,592.64 [February 15, 2021 payroll] and Invoices [for vendors] as presented today [for \$1,586,074.25]. Councilor Shevlot seconded the motion. Following discussion, by a roll call vote, the motion to approve the vouchers carried unanimously.
