ADMINISTRATION COMMENTS: Mayor Collier announced a Labor Day Celebration on September 5, 2020. Flyers will be coming out mid-month. Bids for the paving projects came in \$300,000 less than projected. We can apply \$300,000 to more paving projects.

Controller/Deputy Mayor Fenwick said there was good news last week. The amended bond ordinance for the water utility allowed the maturity to change from 20 years to 30 years. The bonds were sold last week for \$12.5 million. The water utility is A rated. The bonds were sold at a 30-year maturity date at 2.90% interest. This is the lowest interest rate in the history of Lawrence for a 30-year bond. It saved the water utility \$2 million. Controller Fenwick also discussed Phase II of projects for the water utility.
