

PROPOSAL NO. 17, 2024

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
LAWRENCE, INDIANA AMENDING THE LAWRENCE MUNICIPAL
CODE TO ESTABLISH A RESTRICTED PARKING ZONE AND
DESIGNATE HARRISON PARK COURT AS A NO PARKING ANYTIME
STREET**

WHEREAS, Title 3, Article 2, Chapter 4 of the Code of Ordinances (“Code”) of the City of Lawrence, Indiana (the “City”) establishes restricted parking zones throughout the City; and

WHEREAS, the Common Council for the City (“Common Council”) may establish restricted parking zones and designate and determine which streets shall be controlled by “no parking anytime” signs; and

WHEREAS, in order to improve safety near and around Harrison Park Court, the Council desires to declare Harrison Park Court a restricted parking zone and designate Harrison Park Court by signs stating, “no parking anytime.”

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAWRENCE, INDIANA, THAT:

Section 1. The language of Code § 3-2-4-4(A) regarding the streets declared to be restricted parking zones and designated by signs stating “no parking anytime” shall be amended to include the following area to be declared an additional no parking anytime street:

Street	From	To	Sides with No Parking
Harrison Park Court	West Cul-de-sac	East Cul-de-sac	Both (north and south)

Section 2. In the event any one or more of the provisions contained in this Ordinance should be held invalid, illegal, or unenforceable in any respect, the validity, legality, and enforceability of the remaining provisions contained herein shall not in any way be affected or impaired and shall remain in full force and effect, and in lieu of each provision that is found to be illegal, invalid, or unenforceable, a provision will be added as part of this Ordinance that is as similar to the illegal, invalid, or unenforceable provision as may be possible and legal, valid, and enforceable.

Section 3. All resolutions or parts thereof in conflict with the terms and conditions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed and replaced to the extent of the conflict.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its adoption by the Common Council, approval by the Mayor, and publication as required by law.
