

PROPOSAL NO. 18, 2024

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
LAWRENCE, INDIANA AMENDING THE LAWRENCE MUNICIPAL
CODE TO ESTABLISH ALL-WAY STOP INTERSECTIONS
AT BRIARHILL DRIVE AND BENT OAK LANE AND BENT OAK
COURT, AND BENT OAK LANE AND BRIARHILL LANE**

WHEREAS, Title 3, Article 2, Chapter 2 of the Code of Ordinances (“Code”) of the City of Lawrence, Indiana (the “City”) establishes stop streets throughout the City; and

WHEREAS, the Common Council for the City (“Common Council”) may designate and determine which streets and intersections shall be controlled by stop signs; and

WHEREAS, in order to improve safety near and around the intersections of Briarhill Drive and Bent Oak Lane and Bent Oak Court, and Bent Oak Drive and Briarhill Lane (collectively, the “Intersections”), the Common Council desires to make the Intersections all-way stops.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAWRENCE, INDIANA, THAT:

Section 1. The language of Code § 3-2-2-4(B) regarding the intersections designated as all-way stop intersections shall be amended to include the following area to be declared additional all-way stop intersections:

<i>All-Way Stop Intersections</i>
Briarhill Drive and Bent Oak Lane and Bent Oak Court
Bent Oak Lane and Briarhill Lane

Section 2. The language of Code § 3-2-2-4(A) regarding stop streets shall be repealed:

<i>Stop Street</i>	<i>Preferential Street</i>
Briarhill Lane	Bent Oak Lane

Section 3. The language of Code § 3-2-2-4(B) regarding all-way stop intersections shall be repealed:

<i>All-Way Stop Intersections</i>
Briarhill Drive and Bent Oak Lane

Section 4. In the event any one or more of the provisions contained in this Ordinance should be held invalid, illegal, or unenforceable in any respect, the validity, legality, and enforceability of the remaining provisions contained herein shall not in any way be affected or impaired and shall remain in full force and effect, and in lieu of each provision that is found to be illegal, invalid, or unenforceable, a provision will be added as part of this Ordinance that is as similar to the illegal, invalid, or unenforceable provision as may be possible and legal, valid, and enforceable.

Section 5. All resolutions or parts thereof in conflict with the terms and conditions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed and replaced to the extent of the conflict.

Section 6. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its adoption by the Common Council, approval by the Mayor, and publication as required by law.
