



November 24, 2020 – Superintendent’s Report

ADMIN UPDATE:

Utility management is recommending approval of Change Order #5 on the 47th Street Water Main Replacement Project. This is the final change order on this project and it is a reduction of \$37,006.14 on the total contract price, making the final cost of this project \$1,839,711.51, \$42,843.04 over the original contract price of \$1,796,868.47. Pay App #4, which is on the claims list for tonight’s meeting, is the final Pay App for this project and will close the project out. We would like to thank Miller Pipeline and our engineering team at Wessler Engineering for delivering yet another successful project for the City.

There are no additional items for approval at this time and things in Utility operations are business as usual.

CLAIMS EXPLANATIONS: There are two large claims on the list for Miller Pipeline for Pay App 3 on the Elmhurst Sewer Rehab Project and Pay App 4 for the 47th Street Water Main Replacement Project.
