

December 11, 2018 – Superintendent's Report ADMIN UPDATE:

Approvals:

- SAMCO Line Locating Agreement
- Resolution 5, 2018 Changing Policy with regard to Sanitary Sewer Covenants

Work continues on our Wellhead Protection Plan update being performed by ASI. The redelineation final draft is done and returned to them with minor comments and the WHP management plan will be reviewed and a final likely completed in January.

All our water main projects are moving forward, but with nothing significant to report at this time.

The Utility management has requested Wessler to submit an agreement to design a water main extension that will allow the abandonment of an old water main feeding the Edlou subdivision and which would be located under new pavement at the Richardt WTP if it were to remain in place. This project will involve installing a new main along Shadeland Way/56th Street and would connect into the dead end main on Mardyke Lane. This will allow for the Edlou addition to still have a secondary feed while allowing the old main, which presently runs between two residential properties, to be abandoned. The benefits here are to eliminate a potential main failure under our new WTP asphalt while also eliminating another dead end main in the system. We will perform the engineering as a task order under the master services agreement presently in place with Wessler.
