



June 11, 2018 – Superintendent’s Report

ADMIN UPDATE:

The Utility is seeking approval for three DRF’s for our Phase I Water System Improvements Projects:

1. DRF 72 – Wessler Engineering - \$10,407 for engineering work on Richardt and the Wellfield Project
2. DRF 73 – Graves Brothers – \$235,103 - Pay Application 21 for the RWTP Project
3. DRF 74 – Glenroy Construction - \$179,461 – Pay Application 7 for the Wellfield Project

At tonight’s meeting we will also be conducting the second public hearing for the OCRA Sewer Grant Application.

SANITARY SEWER SYSTEM

- 24 – Sanitary sewer lift station work orders performed.
- 5 – Sanitary sewer grinder pump work orders performed.
- 188 LF of sanitary sewer main cleaned.
- 1270 LF of sanitary sewer main CCTV’d.
- Had to set up by-pass pumping of LS 19 due to a failure in the dry pit of the lift station that flooded all the electrical controls for the station. This station was already scheduled to be replaced starting mid-June of this year.
