
Engineer Venugopalan requested approval of Change Order 1 for Midwest Paving for the Harmon Way Reconstruction Project in the amount of \$38,565.10. After discussion, Mr. Clark moved to approve Change Order 1 for the Harmon Way Reconstruction Project. The motion was seconded by Mrs. Browner and after a roll call vote the motion carried 3-0.

Engineer Venugopalan requested approval of Change Order 1 for Preferred Asphalt for the Strip Patching Project in the amount of \$6,927.36. After discussion, Mrs. Browner moved for approval. The motion was seconded by Mr. Clark and after a roll call vote the motion carried 3-0.

ADMINISTRATION COMMENTS: Engineer Venugopalan requested that Street Director Heneghan provide an update to the street lights on 56th Street. Heneghan reported the only service Perfection Group is providing is changing out the bulbs to LED and replacing any broken or missing globes. The Street Department will be replacing two missing fixtures on the bridge and will begin painting them once the heat breaks.
