Petitioners' representative, Kyra Rimsans, presented the case for a Variance of Use of the Consolidated Zoning and Subdivision Ordinance, Chapter 744, Art IX, Section 04.F.1 to allow an EVMS (not permitted) and Chapter 744, Art IX, Section 04.F.2.d to allow an EVMS within 600 feet of a protected district

Larry Calloway, Marion County DMD, recommends denial William Anthony, City of Lawrence, recommends approval

After discussion the Board voted and approved the petition with a 3-2 vote and the following commitments:

- 1. The Electronic Variable Message Sign (the "EVMS") will be turned off between ten o'clock p.m. and six o'clock a.m. each day.
- The EVMS will not flash or have scrolling messages; it will change instantaneously from one static message to another.
- 3. The EVMS screen will change messages no faster than every six seconds.
- 4. The EVMS screen will be one consistent static image during the rush hours of seven thirty o'clock a.m. to nine o'clock a.m. (7:30-9:00 a.m.) and four o'clock p.m. to six o'clock (4:00-6:00 p.m.) during the weekdays (Monday-Friday).
- 5. The EVMS screen shall not have monochromatic messages or messages with a dominant color of red, yellow or green due to potential interference with a signalized intersection.
- 6. The EVMS shall utilize a Datroniks system, or similar system, which shall automatically regulate brightness and dim the message when appropriate.
- 7. The variance is granted to the Metropolitan School District of Lawrence Township and should the Subject Property be sold, the variance shall automatically terminate.

There being no other business before the board the meeting was adjourned at 7:35pm
