# 22-LSV-12 ~ 11705 Pendleton Pike

Variance of Development Standards of the City of Indianapolis consolidated Zoning/Subdivision Ordinance Table 743-1 to allow outdoor seating. Petition filing deadline: July 13, 2022; Peition filed: July 25, 2022; Public Notice deadline: August 6, 2022; Public Notice sent: August 2, 2022. Motion to waive the rules of filing deadline was made by Ms. Alvarez, seconded by Mr. Masur and passed with a 4-0 vote.

# **Old Business:**

#### 22-LSV-10 ~ 7485 E 46th St

Petitioners' representative, Alan Townsend, presented the case for a Variance of Development Standards of the City of Indianapolis consolidated Zoning/Subdivision Ordinance 744-911-7: No advertising sign shall be permitted which displays video or emitting graphics; and 744-911(b)(2)(d): No sign shall be permitted which displays video or emitting graphics.

Councilor Rusomaroff, District 4, questioned the necessity of increasing the intensity of the sign.

Director Zuerner informed the Board that the sign would not be visible to anyone in the City limits unless they are traveling on I-465. INDOT has approved the upgrade to digital.

Ms. Alvarez had several questions regarding the environmental impact of a digital vs static sign. The petitioner's representative did not have answers and was asked to bring this information to our next meeting.

Ms. Alvarez motioned to continue the petition with notice to the September 20, 2022 meeting. Motion was seconded by Mr. Yates and passed 4-0.

### **New Business:**

### 22-LSV-11 ~ 9702 Pendleton Pike

Petitioners' representative, Richard Sprague, presented the case for a Variance of Development Standards of the City of Indianapolis consolidated Zoning/Subdivision Ordinance 744-911.A.9 to allow an advertising sign closer than 1,000 feet from another advertising sign.

Councilor Rusomaroff, District 4, recommended denial of the petition.

Director Zuerner said the City is working to enhance the look of Pendleton Pike from I-465 to Sunnyside in 2023 and is not certain the addition of another billboard would do that.

After discussion the Board voted and denied the petition 1-3

### 22-LSV-12 ~ 11705 Pendleton Pike

Petitioner, Graham Levy, presented the case for a Variance of Development Standards of the City of Indianapolis consolidated Zoning/Subdivision Ordinance Table 743-1 to allow outdoor seating.

Councilor Rusomaroff, District 4, recommends approval.
