<http://indyh2o.org/> will take you to the Marion County Wellfield Education Corporation website with loads of information about protecting our groundwater sources, and contains links for businesses to schedule an assessment or reassessment of their well head protection practices (if the business is located in either the one-year or five-year time of travel area) as well as a “Am I in a Wellfield” link. This link allows anyone to see if their property, whether business or residential, is in a well head protection area. All of Lawrence’s water supply comes from groundwater wells located in either the Richardt or Geist Wellfields. So groundwater protection is everyone’s concern. The MCWEC mandate is to educate and inform, it is not about penalizing or punishing property or business owners.
