This weekend we have the Fiesta going on at the Sterrett Center, opening day for Fall Creek Baseball and Softball at the Community Park.

The wiring of the money from FHRA to the City of Lawrence Parks Department for the Civic Plaza was made yesterday. There is a construction meeting scheduled for May 2, 2022.

The City of Lawrence was awarded 1.7 million dollars for the Trail Grant.

The lights have been installed for the Pickle Ball Courts and the contractor is making the paving corrections. Looking at June 1st for kickoff.

The scraping of the field for the ball mix has been started at Lee Road Park. They will be taking that to Veterans Park and the Community Park to be utilized.

The City of Lawrence Parks Department has 1 full time position open and 4 seasonal positions open.

At the Cultural Campus the amphitheater's roof is going on and the limestone benches will be in by June 1st.

The City of Lawrence clean-up day was April 21st. Jeff commented on how great the Park's guys did cleaning up the parks.
