President Hall called the meeting to order at 5:30 p.m. and announced a quorum.

Mr. Hall asked for a motion to approve the Minutes from March 12, 2019. Mr. Parnell moved to approve the Minutes and Ms. Boyd seconded the motion. The motion was unanimously approved by a vote of 5-0.

Mr. Hall presented the payment of Claims in the amount of \$714,893.88 and the Payroll Voucher in the amount of \$151,171.01. Mr. Gingles moved to approve the claims and payroll voucher and Mr. Parnell seconded the motion. The motion was unanimously approved by a vote of 5-0.

**Superintendent's Report**: Mr. Hall asked Mr. Salsbery to give the Superintendent's Report. Mr. Salsbery reported that everything is running smoothly.

Opening Bids – Lift Station 19 Project: Pursuant to adverting, Mr. Hall opened the floor for opening of bids for Lift Station 19 Project. One bid was received by Evans Development Company. Base bid received was \$1,400,000.00 with mandatory alternates of \$8,000.00 for Mandatory Alternate 1, \$3,900.00 for Mandatory Alternate 2, \$3,100.00 for Mandatory Alternate 3 and \$23,000.00 for Mandatory Alternate 4, bringing the total cost of the bid to \$1,438,000.00. Mr. Salsbery asked project engineer Jeremy Schmitt with Commonwealth Engineers, Inc. to review the bid package and present findings at the next USB meeting.

**Old Business:** Mr. Hall requested moved to remove Change Order No. 1 from Glenroy Construction Co., Inc. for Well Field Improvements from the table. Following discussion, Mr. Parnell made a motion to remove this request from the table and Ms. Boyd seconded the motion. The motion was unanimously approved by a vote of 5-0. Following discussion, Mr. Tekippe made a motion for approval and Mr. Parnell seconded the motion. The motion was unanimously approved by a vote of 5-0.

## **New Business:**

- 1. Mr. Hall opened the discussion for a request for approval to remove \$1,324.36 worth of charges at 9353 Kingsboro Court. Homeowner Ann Green, accompanied by friends Mandy Gonzalez and Greg Smith, presented her case. Following discussion, Mr. Parnell made a motion to table the request for approval to remove \$1,324.36 worth of charges and Ms. Boyd seconded the motion. The motion to table was unanimously approved by a vote of 5-0.
- 2. Mr. Hall requested a motion for approval of SRF Disbursement Request Form #66 from Wessler Engineering for \$21,520.00. Mr. Tekippe made a motion for approval and Mr. Parnell seconded the motion. The motion was unanimously approved by a vote of 5-0.

- 3. Mr. Hall requested a motion for approval of Change Order no. 2 from Glenroy Construction Co., Inc. for Well Field Improvements to increase existing contract for \$20,777.00. Mr. Parnell made a motion for approval and Mr. Tekippe seconded the motion. The motion was unanimously approved by a vote of 5-0.
- 4. Mr. Hall requested a motion for approval of Agreement with Beam, Longest and Neff, LLC for the Brookhaven Neighborhood Water Main Replacement Project for \$220,800.00. Mr. Parnell made a motion for approval and Ms. Boyd seconded the motion. Following discussion, the motion was unanimously approved by a vote of 5-0.
