Cynthia Thrasher, representative for the petitioner, presented the case for a Variance of Development Standards of the Consolidated Zoning and Subdivision Ordinance to provide for a permanent 1,395 square foot tent for an existing produce area (approved by 2002-LUV-013), with a 7.5 foot front setback (40 foot front setback required). Also permitting allowable accessory use of 7811 square foot (1370 square foot allowed)

Marion County DMD, Larry Calloway, recommends approval City of Lawrence, William Anthony, recommends approval with commitment
