Thereupon, Mrs. Gartin, as the only nominee, was elected unanimously by acclamation.

The election of Secretary of the Police Merit Commission was opened for nominations. Mrs. Gartin nominated Ms. Karen Horth Powers for Secretary. Commission President Wheeler three times called for any additional nominations. Mr. Wheeler closed nominations for Secretary. Thereupon, Ms. Powers, as the only nominee, was elected unanimously by acclamation.

<u>APPROVAL OF MINUTES:</u> Mr. Christensen moved to approve the minutes of the regular meeting on December 12, 2022. The motion was seconded by Ms. Powers. By a roll call vote, the motion carried 5-0.

<u>NEW BUSINESS</u>: Captain Schneider requested approval of the 2022 (Session 1) hiring process eligibility list. There are 4 applicants on the eligibility list. Ms. Powers moved to approve the request. The motion was seconded by Mr. Christensen. By a roll call vote, the motion carried 5-0.
