The motion was seconded by Mr. Hendrickson and carried 4-0.

Mr. Hendrickson moved to accept applicants 1-6 based on that standard and have the applicants proceed to the background phase of the hiring process. The motion was seconded by Mr. Christensen and carried 4-0.

Captain Schneider requested the certification of members with the three (3) highest scores for Sergeant: Applicant ID #0532, Applicant ID #0529, and Applicant ID #1738. Mr. Hendrickson moved to certify the members with the 3 highest scores for Sergeant. The motion was seconded by Ms. Powers and carried 4-0.

<u>COMMENTS OF POLICE CHIEF</u>: Captain Schneider reported that on May 15, 2022, she had attended the National Law Enforcement Day ceremonies in Washington D. C. She went on to say that, because this is National Police Week, several individuals have been bringing various gifts and donations to the Lawrence Police Department. She concluded by saluting all the personnel in the Lawrence Police Department for their service to the community.
