



## UPCOMING UTILITY WORK

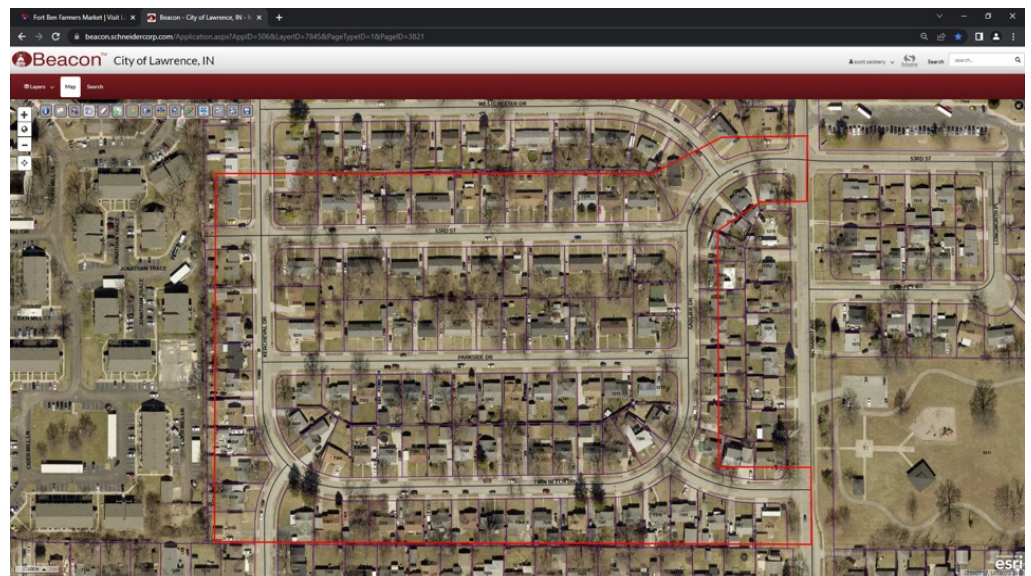
The Brookside Park Water Main Replacement Project will be out for bids and could start as early as late July or in August. Water mains will be replaced along with associated water service line work. In addition, there are stormwater improvements scheduled for this area as well. The stormwater portion of the project is being overseen by Lawrence DPW who have secured funding for the project via an OCRA Grant.

Given the nature of the projects, residents in the area may expect a lot of work in the roadways and yards due to excavations required to perform the work. Traffic flow will be restricted and parking along the streets will be an issue as contractors will have to stockpile materials for backfilling trenches and of course there will be excavating equipment and contractor work vehicles all throughout the area.

We would like to encourage those residents living in the project area to park their vehicles in their driveways as much as possible while construction is ongoing.

We would also like to request that, when a contractor's representative requests that a vehicle be moved, that the owner do so as quickly as possible to avoid delaying progress.

The impacted area is shown below. We greatly appreciate the cooperation of the residents in the area as we get these much-needed infrastructure improvements completed.
