WATER METER REPLACEMENT PROGRAM

Lawrence Utilities continue to work on replacing water meters that need to be upgraded due to age, along with additional features that customers can use such as the EyeOnWater app which allows customers to track usage, set alerts for above normal water usage, etc.

This water meter replacement program is targeted toward customers that have water meters located inside their homes or in their garage.

Lawrence Utilities staff will leave a Blue Tag at your residence if your water meter is one that needs to be replaced. If you receive a Blue Tag for this reason,

please call the Utilities Business Office to schedule a date/time for your water meter to be replaced as soon as possible. If the Utilities does not receive a response after the first Blue Tag is left, a second Blue Tag will be left to inform the customer that their water service may be disrupted until an appointment is scheduled.

To avoid service disruption, please call the Business Office at (317) 542-0511 to schedule an appointment and if you have any questions regarding this matter. You can also ask more about the EyeOnWater app and the features available with that.



GRASS AND IRRIGATION

As we are now in the grass cutting season, we would like to encourage residents to avoid blowing their grass clippings into the street. These clippings get washed down the gutter in rain events and contribute to the clogging up of storm sewers, resulting in drainage backups. Residents should also avoid allowing these clippings to accumulate in ditches and drainage swales, where

they accumulate and prevent the proper movement of surface drainage to where it is supposed to go.

We would like to remind our customers with irrigation systems that it is the season to make sure your backflow preventer has been tested by a certified tester when the irrigation system is activated and the report sent to the

Utility office at backflow@cityoflawrence.org. If backflows are not in compliance with State and Federal guidelines water service may be disrupted. If you don't plan to use your irrigation system, the backflow does need removed and system cut and capped. Lawrence Utilities will need to verify the system is abandoned so please call the Business Office at 317-542-0511 to schedule that verification.
