






# YEAR TO YEAR CRIME COMPARISON (2023-2025)

## SUMMARY OF MAJOR CRIMES TRENDS FROM 2023 – 2025

Overall, most crime categories show a downward trend from 2023 to 2025, with particularly notable decreases in violent crimes. Aggravated assault remained stable from 2023 to 2024 and then declined slightly in 2025. Criminal recklessness dropped substantially over the three-year period, falling by nearly half. Homicide increased slightly in 2024 but then dropped sharply in 2025. Rape showed a small increase from 2023 to 2024 and remained stable in 2025, making it one of the few categories without a decline. Robbery and carjacking both decreased steadily, with carjacking showing a sharp reduction by 2025. Stolen vehicle incidents declined consistently each year, with a significant drop by 2025.

### At-a-glance:

-  **911 calls are steadily decreasing** each year — a drop of about 16% from 2023 to 2025.
-  **non-emergency calls** remain relatively stable
